

**GUILDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL  
THE GUILDFORD OFF STREET PARKING PLACES ORDER 2008**

Guildford Borough Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 32 and 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act"), Regulation 21 and Part IV of Schedule 4 of the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 and the Traffic Management Act 2004 whether generally or in relation to the Council's area (the 2004 Act) and of all other enabling powers and with the consent of Surrey County Council given under Section 39(3) of the 1984 Act and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act hereby makes the following Order.

**PART I**

**GENERAL**

**Commencement and Citation**

1. (1) This Order shall come into operation on 31 March 2008 and may be cited as "The Guildford Off-Street Parking Places Order 2008".
- (2) The Orders specified in Schedule 1 to this Order are hereby revoked.

**Interpretation**

2. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-

**"authorised officer"** means the Council's, Heads of Services, Parking Manager, Assistant Parking Manager (Operations) On Street Parking Coordinator and Assistant Parking Manager (Administration)

**"authorised vehicle"** means a vehicle of a class specified in Column 3 of the Annexes to this Order

**"car park"** shall have the same meaning as "parking place"

**"charging hours"** in relation to a parking place means the period specified as such in Column 6 of an Annex to this Order

**"civil enforcement officer"** means a person authorised by or on behalf of the Council to supervise a parking place or parking places

**"contract parking agreement"** means an agreement between the Council and some other person whereby a vehicle owned, kept, driven or controlled by that person may be left in one of the parking places specified in an Annex to this Order

**"contravention"** means a failure to comply with a provision in this order other than one in relation to a stationary vehicle within a parking place

**"General Regulations"** means The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007 (S.I. 2007/3483)

**"invalid carriage"** and **"motor cycle"** have respectively the same meanings as in Section 136 of the 1984 Act

**"motor car"** means a mechanically propelled vehicle not being a motor cycle or an invalid carriage or a commercial vehicle the weight of which unladen exceeds 30 cwt which is constructed itself to carry a load or passengers

**"owner"** in relation to a vehicle means the person by whom such vehicle is kept and used

**"parking apparatus"** means any or all of the following items described in Parts III and IV of this Order being apparatus of a type and design approved for the purpose of this Order by the Secretary of State

- (i) the rising arm and/or step barrier at the entrance to a parking place;
- (ii) the ticket issuing machines being apparatus which issue:-
  - an entry ticket to the driver of a vehicle entering a parking place indicating the time at which the said vehicle enters the parking place in relation to "pay on foot" parking places;
  - a ticket indicating the payment of a charge and the date and time at which the ticket expires in relation to "pay and display" parking places;
- (iii) the ticket acceptance and pay machines;
- (iv) the exit machines;
- (v) the pass card acceptance machines; and
- (vi) the rising arm and/or step barriers at the parking place exits.

**"parking bay"** means any area of a parking place which is provided for the leaving of a vehicle and indicated by markings on the surface of the parking place

**"parking contravention"** shall have the same meaning as in Part 1 Schedule 7 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and specifically in relation to this order shall mean a contravention in relation to a stationary vehicle in a parking place

**"parking place"** means any area of land specified by name in the Annexes to this Order, the approximate extent of which is shown by a heavy black line on the plan in each Annex, provided by the Council under Section 32(1) of the 1984 Act for use as a parking place

**"pass card"** shall mean a card issued by the Council for use in accordance with Article 22 hereof in the pass card acceptance machines and the exit machines

**"penalty charge"** shall have the same meaning as in Section 92 of the Traffic management Act 2004

**"season ticket"** means a permit issued by the Council to a person whereby a vehicle owned, kept, driven or controlled by that person may be left in car parks at dates and times specified by the Council

**"traffic lane"** means an area of a parking place which is laid out by lines or otherwise as a traffic lane or any part of any land or walkway that is intended for use as an access between the parking place and a nearby public highway or, where a parking place is provided with parking bays, any area which is not laid out as a parking bay

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

## **PART II**

### **USE OF PARKING PLACES**

3. Each area of land specified by name in the Annexes to this Order, the approximate extent of which is shown by a heavy black line on the plan in each Annex, may be used subject to the following provisions of this Order as a parking place for such classes of vehicles in such positions and on such days and during such hours and on payment of such charges as are specified in relation to that area in each Annex to this Order.
4. Where in an Annex to this Order a parking place is described as available for vehicles of a specified class or in a specified position the driver of a vehicle shall not park the vehicle in that parking place unless it is:-
  - (i) of the specified class; and
  - (ii) in the specified position.
5. Except with the express consent of an authorised officer of the Council, the driver of a vehicle shall not park the vehicle in the parking place for longer than the maximum period permitted for parking specified in Column 5 of an Annex to this Order in relation to that parking place. The following specific conditions shall also apply to the following parking places:-
  - (i) in respect of North Street Car Park and North Street Heavy Vehicle Park (Annexes 31 and 32 respectively to this Order), when a vehicle has left the parking places after waiting thereon, the driver thereof shall not within two hours after its leaving permit it to wait again upon the parking place; and
  - (ii) in respect of Station Parade (East Horsley) Car Park (Annex 37 to this Order), the driver of any vehicle and the owner of any caravan or trailer shall not permit the same to be in the parking place (or any part thereof) for longer than three hours at any one time and shall not after its leaving permit it to be again in the parking place on that day during charging hours.
6. The driver of a motor vehicle using a parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the parking place and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the parking place.
7. No person shall without the written consent of an authorised officer of the Council use a vehicle while it is in a parking place in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skill or services.
8. No person shall in a parking place without the written consent of the Council (which may be given on such terms and conditions as it thinks fit):-
  - (i) sell or offer for sale anything whatsoever;
  - (ii) make any collection of money or articles of charitable or other purposes; or
  - (iii) advertise or publish by any means any event, display, entertainment, sale, business, shop, organisation, collection or other thing.

9. No person shall in a parking place:-
- (i) play any ball game or game using a ball;
  - (ii) ride any bicycle, moped, scooter or motorcycle unless proceeding directly to or from an area designated or otherwise permitted to be used for the parking of these vehicles;
  - (iii) be in the parking place other than for the purpose of parking a vehicle or purposes connected thereto;
  - (iv) use any roller skates or blades, skate or snake board; or
  - (v) remain in the car park after being told to leave by an officer, employee or person engaged by the Council or police officer.
10. No person shall, except with the permission of any person duly authorised by the Council, drive any vehicle in a parking place other than for the purpose of leaving that vehicle in the parking place in accordance with the provision of this Order or for the purpose of departing from the parking place.
11. No persons shall in a parking place:-
- (i) wantonly shout or otherwise make any loud noise to the disturbance or annoyance of users of the parking place or residents of premises in the neighbourhood; or
  - (ii) sound any horn or other similar instrument, except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the parking place.
12. No person shall in a parking place use any threatening abusive or insulting language, gesture or conduct with intent to put any person in fear or so as to occasion a breach of the peace or whereby a breach of the peace is likely to be occasioned.
13. No person shall without the consent of any person duly authorised by the Council leave or cause to be left unattended in any parking place other than in a designated trolley park any shopping or supermarket trolley.
14. No person shall use any part of a parking place or any vehicle left in a parking place:-
- (i) for sleeping or camping or washing purposes;
  - (ii) for eating or cooking purposes; or
  - (iii) for the purpose of servicing or washing any vehicle or part thereof other than is reasonably necessary to enable that vehicle to depart from the parking place
15. No person shall so use a parking place as a means of passage by vehicle from one road to another road.

16. Where in a parking place signs are erected or surface markings are laid for the purpose of:-
- (i) indicating the entrance to or exit from the parking place; or
  - (ii) indicating that a vehicle using the parking place shall proceed in a specified direction or at not more than a specified speed within the parking place
- no person shall cause or permit to be driven any vehicle:-
- (a) so that it enters the parking place otherwise than by an entrance or leaves the parking place otherwise than by an exit so indicated; or
  - (b) in a direction or in excess of a speed other than that specified as the case may be.
17. In a parking place, no person shall:-
- (i) erect or cause or permit to be erected any tent, booth, stand, building or other structure without the written consent of the Council; or
  - (ii) light or cause or permit to be lit any fire, stove or cooker.
18. Notwithstanding the provisions of this Order, the Council may by notice displayed at or near a parking place close such a parking place or part thereof or reserve such parking place or part thereof for any period and no driver of any vehicle shall use such parking place or part thereof when it is so closed without the Council's consent in writing.
19. Where within a parking place there is a sign or surface marking which indicates that a parking bay is available only for a disabled person's vehicle, the driver of a vehicle shall not park the vehicle in that parking bay unless it is a disabled person's vehicle displaying a disabled person's badge issued by any local authority in accordance with the provisions of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 or any statutory replacement or re-enactment or a badge having effect under those Regulations as if it were a disabled person's badge.
20. (1) Where within the boundaries of a parking place there are double yellow lines, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be parked on or alongside such yellow lines.
- (2) The driver of a vehicle while it is in a parking place shall not permit it to wait in a traffic lane.

### **PART III**

#### **PAY ON FOOT SYSTEM**

21. The charge for an authorised vehicle parked in a parking place using the pay on foot system during the charging hours shall be that specified in Column 7 of an Annex to this Order.
22.
  - (1) The Council may on application issue a pass card on payment of a charge agreed between the Council and the applicant.
  - (2) Subject to Article 18 of this Order, a pass card so issued shall be valid during the period agreed between the Council and the applicant therefore.
  - (3) The driver of a vehicle who uses a pass card in a parking place shall upon demand by a parking attendant produce the pass card to the parking attendant for inspection.
  - (4) The pass card shall not be used except by or with the authority of the person to whom it has been issued.
23. The following provisions shall govern the method of payment of the charge by drivers who are not pass card holders in a parking place:-
  - (i) The driver of an authorised vehicle who intends to park the said vehicle in a parking place shall stop at the rising arm at the entrance to the parking place.
  - (ii) The driver shall then take from the ticket issuing machine the ticket (hereinafter called "the entry ticket") tendered to the driver by the said machine and shall retain the entry ticket.
  - (iii) The driver shall immediately upon the raising of the rising arm barrier drive his vehicle to a parking bay.
  - (iv) When the driver intends to remove his vehicle from the parking place, he shall proceed on foot to the machine provided (hereinafter called "the ticket acceptance and pay machine") and insert the entry ticket into the slot indicated.
  - (v) Upon the ticket acceptance and pay machine indicating the charge to be paid, the driver shall pay the charge so indicated by inserting the appropriate payment into the said machine.
  - (vi) After the driver has complied with paragraph (v) above, the said machine shall issue to the driver a ticket (hereinafter called "the exit ticket") which shall be retained by the driver to permit exit from the parking place.
  - (vii) The driver shall retain the exit ticket issued and immediately drive the said vehicle to the rising arm and/or step barrier at the exit from the parking place and then insert the exit ticket into the machine provided (hereinafter called "the exit machine"). If the driver fails to drive the said vehicle immediately to the rising arm and/or step barrier at the exit from the parking place and because of such delay the exit machine does not accept the exit ticket issued in accordance with paragraph (vi) above, he shall be liable to

pay the balance of charges then due as specified in Column 7 of an Annex to this Order in accordance with paragraphs (iv) to (vi) of this Article.

- (viii) When at the exit of the parking place the rising arm barrier is raised or the step barrier is lowered and the green light signal is displayed, the driver shall immediately drive his vehicle from the parking place.
- (ix) In the event of a driver of an authorised vehicle being unable to produce either the entry ticket or the exit ticket through loss or any other cause whatsoever or being responsible for damage to either ticket, he shall be liable to pay the maximum daily charge specified for the car park concerned.
- (x) If a period of 10 minutes has elapsed from the expiration of the period allowed for the insertion of the exit ticket in the exit machine prescribed by paragraph (vii) above, the exit machine shall reject the exit ticket and the driver shall immediately proceed to a ticket acceptance and pay machine and insert the exit ticket into the slot provided on the said machine and the driver shall then comply with paragraphs (v) to (viii) of this Article.

24. The following provisions shall govern the use of a parking place by the driver of a vehicle who is entitled to use a pass card in accordance with Article 22 hereof:-

- (i) The driver of an authorised vehicle who intends to park his vehicle in the parking place shall stop the vehicle at the rising arm at the entrance to the parking place.
- (ii) The driver shall then insert the pass card into the slot in the machine provided for the acceptance of pass cards (hereinafter called "the pass card acceptance machine").
- (iii) The driver shall then take the pass card from the pass card acceptance machine and retain it.
- (iv) When the rising arm barrier is raised, the driver shall immediately drive the vehicle to a parking bay.
- (v) When the driver intends to remove his vehicle from the parking place, he shall drive the vehicle to and stop at the rising arm barrier or the step barrier and traffic signal at the exit from the parking place.
- (vi) The driver shall then insert the pass card in the slot provided for pass cards in the exit machine.
- (vii) The driver shall then retrieve the pass card from the exit machine and retain it.
- (viii) Upon the raising of the rising arm barrier or the lowering of the step barrier and the display of the green light signal, the driver shall immediately drive the vehicle from the parking place.

## **PART IV**

### **PAY AND DISPLAY SYSTEM**

25. (1) The driver of an authorised vehicle using a parking place where the pay and display system is in operation shall pay the appropriate charge in accordance with the scale of charges specified in Column 7 of an Annex to this Order:-

Provided that no charge shall be payable by the driver of a vehicle left in any parking place specified in an Annex to this Order who displays a valid parking season ticket or permit and where there subsists a valid contract parking agreement by virtue of which that vehicle may be left in that parking place at that time and the sum due to the Council under such agreement has been paid.

- (2) The charge referred to in the preceding paragraph shall be payable in any parking place specified in an Annex to this Order by the insertion of the appropriate payment in the ticket issuing machine provided in such parking place
- (3) Upon payment of the charge for parking a vehicle in any parking place specified in an Annex to this Order, the driver thereof shall display on the vehicle the ticket issued by the ticket issuing machine by affixing the ticket to the inside surface of the windscreen so that it is facing forwards and can be easily seen from the front of the vehicle and shall continue to display such ticket during the whole of the time that such vehicle remains in such parking place.
- (4) The ticket referred to in paragraph (3) of this Article shall be displayed on the vehicle so that the time and other particulars shown on the said ticket are clearly visible from outside the vehicle.
- (5) Upon payment of the charge for a season ticket or permit for parking a vehicle in a parking place specified in an Annex to this Order, the driver thereof shall display the season ticket or permit on the inside front dashboard or inside surface of the windscreen of the motor vehicle so that it is facing forwards and the particulars shown on the said season ticket or permit are clearly visible from outside the vehicle and shall continue to display such season ticket or permit during the whole of the time that such vehicle remains in such parking place.
- (6) Where a vehicle without a windscreen is left in a parking place, the ticket, season ticket or permit referred to in paragraphs (3) and (5) of this Article shall be displayed by the driver of that vehicle in accordance with paragraph (4) of this Article and shall continue to be so displayed during the whole of the time that such vehicle remains in the parking place.
- (7) Payment of the charge for a vehicle left in a parking place specified in an Annex to this Order shall be indicated by the issue by a ticket issuing machine of a numbered ticket indicating that the charge has been paid in respect of the initial period for which it was paid and the day and time of payment of the charge or by the prior issue by the Council of a season ticket or permit and by the display of the said ticket, season ticket or permit on the vehicle in the manner specified in paragraphs (3), (4), (5) and (6) of this Article.



- (8) The driver of a vehicle left in a parking place specified in an Annex to this Order shall display on the vehicle the valid permit referred to in paragraph (1) of this Article by displaying the permit on the inside front dashboard or the inside surface of the windscreen of the motor vehicle so that it is facing forwards and the particulars of the said permit can be easily seen from the front of the vehicle and shall continue to display such permit during the whole of the time that such vehicle remains in such parking place.

## **PART V**

### **ENFORCEMENT PROVISIONS**

#### **Penalty Charge**

26. The General Regulations apply to any parking contravention committed under this Order, a penalty charge shall be payable for each such contravention and in circumstances described in the regulations vehicles may be immobilised.

#### **Contraventions**

27. A contravention of the provisions of this Order is an Offence under Section 35A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

#### **Manner of Payment of Penalty Charge and other Charges**

28. A penalty charge must be paid within 28 days of the issue of the penalty charge notice as referred to in the General Regulations by cheque, banker's draft, money, order or postal order which shall be delivered or sent by post or by cash in person to the Borough Treasurer's Department of the Council at Millmead House, Millmead, Guildford GU2 4BB or by credit or debit card payment through such automated telephone or internet based payment methods as the Council may from time to time accept.

#### **Restriction on Removal of Notices and Tickets**

29. Where a ticket, season ticket or permit has been exhibited on a vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 25 of this Order, no person not being the driver of the vehicle shall remove the ticket, season ticket or permit unless authorised to do so by the driver.

#### **Exemption from Charges**

30. The following vehicles left in a parking place which is not reserved for contract parking or operating a pay on foot system shall be exempt from any charge specified in any Annex to this Order:-
- (i) an invalid carriage;
  - (ii) a vehicle issued to a disabled person by a Government Department in lieu of an invalid carriage;
  - (iii) a vehicle left by the driver thereof who is a person who on account of his or her severe physical disabilities has been given a notice in writing by the Council

that he or she is exempt from any such charge or limitation on time if the notice is displayed on the vehicle in a conspicuous position; and

- (iv) a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge issued by any local authority in accordance with the provisions of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 or a badge having effect under those Regulations as if it were a disabled person's badge.

#### **Movement of Vehicle Left in Parking Place**

- 31. (i) Where any vehicle is standing in a parking place in contravention of any of the provisions contained in this Order, a civil enforcement officer or other person authorised in that behalf by the Council may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle and he may remove the vehicle from the parking place or cause it to be removed and where it is so removed shall provide for its safe custody.
  - (ii) Any person removing or altering the position of a vehicle by virtue of the foregoing provisions of this Article may do so by towing or driving the vehicle or in such other manner as he may think necessary and may take such measures in relation to the vehicle as he may think necessary to enable him to remove it or alter its position as the case may be.
32. Any civil enforcement officer or other person duly authorised by the Council or a Police Constable in uniform may move or cause to be moved in the case of emergency to any place he thinks fit vehicles left in the parking place.

## **PART VI**

### **DISPOSAL OF VEHICLES ABANDONED IN PARKING PLACES**

33. The Council may as respects a vehicle which has been or could at any time be removed from a parking place in pursuance of Article 31 of this Order if it appears to them to have been abandoned make arrangements to sell or otherwise dispose of the vehicle provided that the power to arrange disposal conferred by this Article shall not be exercisable in the case of a vehicle unless there have been taken by the Council such of the following steps as are applicable to the vehicle and there has elapsed a period of six weeks beginning with the taking of the first of those steps:-
- (i) Subject to the provisions of Article 39 of this Order, where a vehicle carries a registration mark issued under the Vehicles Excise and Regulation Act 1994, the Council shall apply in writing to the Driver and Vehicle Licensing Centre enquiring who it appears may be the registered keeper of the vehicle and the address of that person.
  - (ii) Where the Council acts under the last paragraph, the first step for the purpose of the last and the next succeeding Article shall be taken to be the sending of the Notice mentioned in Article 34.
34. The Council shall where it is by virtue of the last preceding Article aware of the name and address of a person who it appears may be the owner of the vehicle send a Notice to that person at that address stating that it is the intention of the Council to make arrangements to sell or otherwise dispose of the vehicle (which shall be sufficiently described in the Notice) on or after a specified date (which shall not be less than two weeks from the date of the Notice and in any event not earlier than six weeks from the date of the first step taken by the Council under this Part of this Order) unless it is in the meantime removed by or on behalf of that person from such place as may be specified by the Council in the said Notice or from such other place as may be subsequently notified in writing by the Council to that person.
35. If any person to whom a Notice is sent in accordance with the last preceding Article informs the Council of the name and address of some other person who he alleges may be the owner of the vehicle a Notice stating the particulars mentioned in the last preceding Article shall be sent to that other person and to any further person who the Council may in consequence of the sending of the Notice to the said other person be led to believe may be the owner of the vehicle.
36. Subject to the provisions of Article 39 of this Order, where a vehicle does not carry a registration mark issued under the Vehicles Excise and Regulation Act 1994, the first step to be taken by the Council shall be to apply in writing to the chief officer of the police force in whose area is the parking place from which the vehicle has been or could at any time be removed enquiring who that officer considers is the owner of the vehicle and the address of that person.
37. If after steps have been taken under the foregoing provisions of this Part of this Order a vehicle is not claimed, the Council shall make such further enquiries (if any) as it considers reasonable as to who may be the owner of the vehicle and the address of that person.
38. Where by virtue of Articles 36 and 37 of this Order the Council is informed of the name and address of a person who it is considered may be the owner of the vehicle, Articles 34 and 35 of this Order as respects the sending of Notices shall apply in

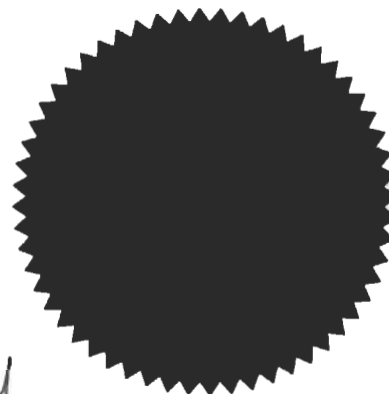
relation to that person at that address as they apply in relation to the person mentioned in the said Article 34

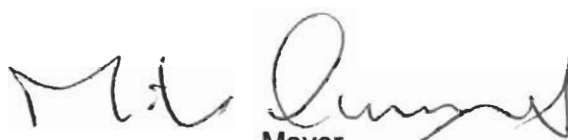
39. Nothing in the foregoing provisions in this Part of this Order shall require the Council to take any such step as is therein mentioned for the purpose of enquiring who is the owner of a vehicle to which Article 33 of this Order applies if it has found a person who satisfied it that he is in fact the owner of that vehicle and it has sent him at his address a Notice containing the particulars specified in Article 34 of this Order, the sending of the Notice being treated as the first step for the purpose of that Article and the said Article 33.
40. The Council shall apply the proceeds of sale of a vehicle in or towards the satisfaction of any costs incurred by it in connection with the removal, storage and disposal of the vehicle hereunder and of any charge to payment of which it is entitled as regards the vehicle under Section 5 of the Refuse Disposal (Amenity) Act 1978 and the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1968 (as amended).
41. In the event of any such costs incurred by it in connection with the removal and disposal of the vehicle not being satisfied by virtue of the last preceding Article, the Council may recoup those costs so far as not satisfied from the person who was the last owner of the vehicle before it was removed from the parking place either in pursuance of this Order or after it has been disposed of by virtue of the powers conferred by this Order if that person was sent by the Council a Notice under the foregoing provisions of this Part of this Order stating the particulars mentioned in Article 34 of this Order.
42. Any sums received by the Council on a sale of the vehicle after deducting any sum applied thereout by virtue of Article 40 of this Order shall be payable within a period of one year from the date of the sale of the vehicle to any person to whom but for such sale the vehicle would have belonged.
43. Where under the foregoing provisions of this Order a Notice is required to be sent to a person, the Notice shall be sent by registered post or by the recorded delivery service.

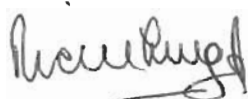
