

**GUILDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL
THE GUILDFORD OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES
(AMENDMENT) (NO. 1) ORDER 2010**

Guildford Borough Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 32, 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) ("the 1984 Act"), Regulation 21 and Part IV of Schedule 4 of the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 and the Traffic Management Act 2004 whether generally or in relation to the Council's area and of all other enabling powers and with the consent of Surrey County Council given under Section 39(3) of the 1984 Act and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the 1984 Act hereby makes the following Order:-

Commencement and Citation

This Order shall come into operation on 01 April 2010 and may be cited as "The Guildford Off-Street Parking Places (Amendment) (No. 1) Order 2010.

Amendments

The Order, as specified in the Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as "the Order"), shall have effect, subject to the following amendments:-

1. The replacement of Annex's 1,2,2a,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10,11,12,13,14,15,15a,16,17,18,19,20,21, 22,23,24,25,26,27,28,29,30,31,32,33,34,34a,35,36,37,38,39,40,41,42,42a,43, and 44 to the Order with the attached Annex's Revised 2010 and As at 2010 incorporating changes to the car park areas, car park charges, charging hours and maximum periods of waiting.
2. The insertion of Annex 26a, namely "Morrow Park and Ride", to the Order with the attached Annex 26A.
3. The insertion of Clause 5. (iii) as follows within the order as follows:-

(iii) in respect of Guildford Spectrum Car Park (Annex 19 to this Order) when a vehicle has left area A of the parking place after waiting thereon the driver thereof shall not within two hours after its leaving permit it to wait again upon area A of the parking place.

4. In clause 28 the words Borough Treasurer's Department of the Council at Millmead House, Millmead, Guildford, GU2 4BB shall be deleted and replaced by the following words **Parking Office, Bedford Road multi-storey car park, Level 2, Laundry Road, Guildford, GU1 4PX.**
5. The insertion in clause 2 of the following expressions:-

"Council Holiday" any day Monday to Friday on which the council offices at Millmead House Guildford GU2 4BB are closed to the public

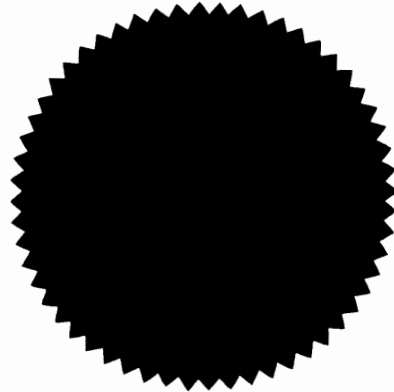
"Boxing Day" shall be the 26 December in any year

6. At the end of clauses 21 and of the first paragraph 25 (1) of the Order the following words shall be added **save that on Boxing Day a flat rate charge of £1 per visit shall apply in all parking places where a charge applies**
