

**GUILDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL
THE GUILDFORD OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES
(AMENDMENT) (NO.3) ORDER 2014**

Guildford Borough Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 32,35 and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) ("the 1984 Act"), the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 and the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers and with the consent of Surrey County Council given under Section 39(3) of the 1984 Act and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Surrey Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the 1984 Act hereby makes the following Order:-

Commencement and Citation

This Order shall come into operation on 25th August 2014 and may be cited as "The Guildford Off-Street Parking Places (Amendment) (No. 3) Order 2014".

Amendments

The Order, as specified in the Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as "the Order"), shall have effect, subject to the following amendments:-

1. The replacement of Annex 7 to the Order with the attached Annex which incorporates a change of name from Black Horse House Car Park to Connaught House Car Park and provides for contract parking only seven days per week.
2. The replacement of Annex 40 to the Order with the attached Annex which incorporates a change of name from York Road (Catholic Church) Car Park to St Joseph's Church Car Park.
3. The deletion of the existing Part IV of the Order and the addition of the following words:

Part IV

PAY AND DISPLAY SYSTEM

25. (1) The driver of an authorised vehicle using a parking place where the pay and display system is in operation shall pay the appropriate charge in accordance with the scale of charges specified in Column 7 of the appropriate Annex to this Order:-

Provided that no further charge shall be payable by the driver of a vehicle left in any parking place specified in an Annex to this Order who displays a valid parking season ticket or permit and where there subsists a valid contract parking agreement by virtue of which that vehicle may be left in that parking place at that time and the sum due to the Council under such agreement has been paid.

- (2) The charge referred to in paragraph (1) of this Article shall be payable in any parking place specified in an Annex to this Order:
- (i) By the insertion of the appropriate payment in the ticket issuing machine provided in such parking place and compliance with paragraphs (3) and (4) of this Article, or
 - (ii) In any parking place where a notice in accordance with paragraph (10) of this Article is displayed, by payment using a credit or debit card by way of mobile telephone communication to the Council in accordance with paragraphs (7),(8) and (9) of this Article.

- (3) Upon payment of the charge for parking a vehicle in any parking place in accordance with paragraph (2)(i) of this Article, the driver thereof shall display on the vehicle the ticket issued by the ticket issuing machine showing the amount paid and the period for which it has been paid by affixing the ticket to the inside surface of the windscreen so that it is facing forwards and can be easily seen from the front of the vehicle and shall continue to display such ticket during the whole of the time that such vehicle remains in such parking place.
- (4) The ticket referred to in paragraph (3) of this Article shall be displayed on the vehicle so that the time and other particulars shown on the said ticket are clearly visible from outside the vehicle.
- (5) Upon payment of the charge for a season ticket or permit for parking a vehicle in a parking place specified in an Annex to this Order, the driver thereof shall display the season ticket or permit on the inside front dashboard or inside surface of the windscreen of the vehicle so that it is facing forwards and the particulars shown on the said season ticket or permit are clearly visible from outside the vehicle and shall continue to display such season ticket or permit during the whole of the time that such vehicle remains in the parking place.
- (6) Where a vehicle without a windscreen is left in a parking place, the ticket, season ticket or permit referred to in paragraphs (3), (4) and (5) of this Article shall be displayed by the driver of that vehicle in accordance with paragraph (4) of this Article and shall continue to be so displayed during the whole of the time that such vehicle remains in the parking place.
- (7) Where payment is made by credit or debit card by mobile telephone in accordance with paragraph (2)(ii) of this Article, the person making payment shall provide:
 - (a) The telephone number of the mobile telephone used to make the payment,
 - (b) The identification number and any other details as may be requested by or on behalf of the Council relating to the credit or debit card against which the payment is made,
 - (c) The location number of the parking place in respect of which the payment is made,
 - (d) The registration number of the vehicle in respect of which the payment is made.
- (8) Where payment is made by mobile telephone, the driver shall pay a transaction fee of 12 pence (10p + VAT) in addition to the appropriate parking charge specified in Column 7 of the appropriate Annex to this Order.
- (9) Where payment is made by mobile telephone, the period for which payment is made shall commence on receipt by or on behalf of the Council of the details specified in paragraph (7) of this Article, but that period may be extended on further payment of the appropriate charge specified in column 7 of the appropriate Annex together with the transaction fee referred to in paragraph (8) of this Article provided that the maximum period permitted for parking in that parking place is not exceeded.
- (10) The Council shall display a notice in every car park in which the option to pay by mobile telephone in accordance with paragraph 2(ii) is available, such notice to include the location number of the car park, the transaction charge payable, the telephone number which drivers must telephone and information on how to pay the parking charge.

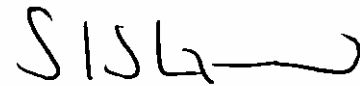
